This morning enjoy a comprehensive tour Georgetown city. Experience the sights & sounds of this quaint city. Discover the diversity of this multi cultured society who lives harmoniously together in this city. Among the highlights of the tour are: -

- ❖ **Fort Cornwallis**
Fort Cornwallis marks the spot where the British fleet, under Captain Francis Light disembarked. Although little remains of the original site, there is the Sri Rambai cannon located here to denote history.
- ❖ **Weld Quay**
Following reclamation of the land of Beach Street, Weld Quay became the sea-front road of Penang's port settlement. The jetty of the Chew clan is one of Penang's many "clan jetties", this are actually clan villages built on water. The houses here are made of timber and joined by plank walkways.
- ❖ **Khoo Kong Si**
The Khoo Kong Si clan house has magnificent example of intricate wood carvings with Chinese architecture. This extravagant building is partly temple and a meeting hall for Chinese of the same clan or surname.
- ❖ **Street of Harmony – Jalan Masjid Kapitan Keling**
Affectionately known as the Street of Harmony, for here are found four historical houses of worship, all in the same row. the Goddess of Mercy, oldest Chinese temple in Penang, the Sri Mariamman, a Hindu temple with brightly coloured sculptures and swans, the Kapitan Keling Mosque the oldest mosque in Penang and St. George's Church.
- ❖ **Penang Museum & Art Gallery**
The museum has an excellent collection of memorabilia such as rickshaws, press clipping, photographs and a whole assortment of paraphernalia.
