This afternoon, sit back and enjoy a leisurely trishaw ride and stroll the city of Georgetown. Discover the multi-cultured lifestyle of the city folks who live harmoniously in this city. Amongst the highlights of the tour are:-

- ❖ **Fort Cornwallis**
The Fort that was originally built in wooden stockade was replaced by concrete structure built by convicts in 1804. It was here that marked the historic landing site of Sir Francis Light's in 1786.
- ❖ **Weld Quay**
The water villages found at Weld Quay has been in existence since the 19th century. With an interesting blend of cultural and religious activities in this settlement, there's never a dull moment. Even with the development taking place all over, Weld Quay still remains untouched.
- ❖ **Khoo Kong Si**
Known to be the grandest clan house in the country, the Khoo Kong Si clan house has magnificent examples of intricate wood carvings of Chinese architecture.
- ❖ **Street of Harmony – Jalan Masjid Kapitan Keling**
Stop by the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy temple which is the oldest Chinese temple in Penang. Move on to the Sri Mariamman Temple, a typical Hindu temple with its brightly coloured sculptures and swans. Then, drive pass one of the oldest mosque in Penang and a church. Experience it all on the same street.
- ❖ **Pinang Peranakan Mansion**
This Peranakan Mansion which was built at the end of the 19th century contains elaborate remnant of the fascinating history on the lifestyle of the Baba Nyonya's in Penang.
- ❖ **E&O Hotel – High tea**
Enjoy a classic English High-Tea set amid the historic grandeur and the colonial charm of E&O Hotel.
